controversy. The decade proposed is to allow a wide variety of cars, and avoid the rolling billboards of the modern WRC. This will, I hope, encourage some kitbashing, scratch building, within the scope of the rules we end up with.

There should be an ample supply of RTR cars, both newly available, and on eBay

that will fit the bill for the series. And since the series would be run on the rally track, and the cars are for the most part narrow and tall, a mild spec motor is called for (Predator 12k, for example)

In order to allow sufficient time to prepare cars, H2, or Q4 are suggested. I also propose a Concours to be held after the final race (stage) just like the real Monte. And the Concours will carry as many points as a race., with the bulk of scoring being as objective as possible (Box stock<relivery, relivery< resin ir static kit co

nversion, etc.) It would be ideal to have a third party do the judging (Kings?) I can start work on some preliminary rules if there is interest.
